Day 4 07-19-23 (Wednesday)

Venice-Innsbruck-Kufstein

Day 5 07-20-23 (Thursday)

Kufstein-Salzburg

We start for our day trip to the romantic city of Salzburg, Austria. The streets are filled with buskers, opera singers and all manners of harmonic performers. The city offers melodies that bore one of the greatest composers of all time, Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart. We will have a tour within the original sights of the famous movie and classic "The Sound of Music". Kufstein - Mayrhofen

In the morning, we leave Kufstein and pass the border to reach Germany. We drive to Munich, Bavaria's famous capital. After a city tour, we will enjoy a lunch at the well-known restaurant, Hofbräuhaus, and then we continue to Dornbirn, Austria. Dinner and overnight in Dornbirn.

Day 8 07-23-23 (Sunday)

Friedrichshafen-Neuschwanstein- Opera "Puccini-Madame Butterfly"

Beautiful mountains, a quaint village nestled into a valley, waterfalls, and a Fairytale Castle. With a description like that, we know why Walt Disney took this castle as a role model for his logo. We enjoy a free day to sleep in and relax. You may enjoy strolling through the town of Konstanz and go shopping or just walk around this beautiful town.



We continue to Zermatt, a cute and quaint town that sits at the base of the Swiss Alps. You will love the beauty of this place!
